

Programa de examen para alumnos Regulares: Inglés II

2º año NIVEL INICIAL – Diciembre 2020

UNIDADES:

Starter unit

Vocabulary: free time. Video games, music, art, animals, etc.. Prepositions and everyday objects.

Grammar: affirmative and negative verb to be; subject pronouns and possessive adjectives. Possessive 's. Be: questions.

Reading comprehension / Listening.

Unidad 1: TOWN AND CITIES

Vocabulary: places in a town or city. Vocabulary plus: fantastic, comfortable; swimming pool; etc. Comparing places: old, quiet, pretty, etc..

Grammar: there is/there are + a, an, some and any. Is there...?, Are there...?, How many...? Comparative adjectives

Reading comprehension / Listening.

Unidad 2: DAYS

Vocabulary: daily routines: get up, have classes, study, etc.. Vocabulary plus: son, daughter, parent, etc. Present simple: time expressions.

Grammar: present simple: affirmative and negative forms; present simple: questions.

Reading comprehension / Listening.

Unidad 3: WILD LIFE

Vocabulary: animals.

Grammar: superlative adjectives. Can for ability. Questions with "how".

Reading comprehension / Listening.

Unidad 4: LEARNING WORLD

Vocabulary: school subjects: maths, English, history, etc.. Vocabulary plus: primary school, private school, boarding school; verbs: studying a language, listen, check, repeat, etc..

Grammar: present continuous: affirmative, negative and questions; contrasting present continuous and simple.

Reading comprehension / Listening.

Unidad 6: SPORT

Vocabulary: sports; the Olympic games then and now.

Grammar: there was/were; was/were; regular and irregular verbs. Past simple: affirmative and negative.

Reading comprehension / Listening.

READER: *Theseus and the Minotaur* – Editorial Pearson.

BOOK: *ENGLISH PLUS 1* - Editorial Oxford

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2º año NIVEL INTERMEDIO – Diciembre 2020

Unidad 5: IN THE CITY

Vocabulary: Places in a town and cities. Prepositions of place. Town and country. Compass points and continents. Adjectives to describe towns and cities.

Grammar: Comparative adjectives. Superlative adjectives. Recycle: there is / are.

Reading comprehension / Listening.

Unidad 6: GOING WILD

Vocabulary: wild animals (bear, shark, etc.); parts of an animal (paw, tail, etc.). Natural world. Actions. Adventure holiday activities.

Grammar: past simple regular verbs; past time expressions; past simple: be and can. Prepositions of movement and place. Recycle: comparative and superlative forms.

Reading comprehension / Listening.

Unidad 7: DIGITAL WORLD

Vocabulary: computing nouns, computing verbs; technology collocations. Internet phrases. Prices. Gadgets.

Grammar: past simple irregular verbs; past simple negative and interrogative forms; phrasal verbs: computers.

Reading comprehension / Listening.

Unidad 8: BE ACTIVE!

Vocabulary: Sports (aerobics; skiing, etc.). Verbs (play, do and go). Nationalities. Athletic events. Sports equipment.

Grammar: going to / will. Future expressions. Noun suffixes.

Reading comprehension / Listening.

READER: *Les Miserables* by Victor Hugo – Editorial Oxford.

BOOK: *SOLUTIONS Elementary* - Editorial Oxford.

2º año NIVEL AVANZADO – Diciembre 2020

Unidad 5: AMBITION

Vocabulary: Jobs. Describing jobs. Work activities. Personal qualities.

Grammar: Will and going to. Using adverbs to make predictions more or less certain. First conditional. Single words vs. hyphenated words.

Reading comprehension / Listening.

Unidad 6: TOURISM

Vocabulary: Visitor attractions; at an airport: compound nouns; holidays: compound nouns; tourist attractions; holiday attractions.

Grammar: present perfect; contrast: past simple and present perfect. Compound nouns: noun + noun and adjective + noun.

Reading comprehension / Listening.

Unidad 7: MONEY

Vocabulary: numbers and currencies. Shops and services. Shopping. Business. Verbs to do with money.

Grammar: Second conditional. Past perfect. Verbs + infinitive or –ing.

Reading comprehension / Listening.

Unidad 8: CRIME

Vocabulary: crimes and criminals (arson, smuggler, etc.). Everyday items. Compound nouns.

Grammar: Reported speech (pronoun and time expressions in reported speech); tell and say. Adjective suffixes.

Reading comprehension / Listening.
